In her five-minute prepared speech, the Kolej Tuanku Ja'afar A-Level student talked about how schools stifled creativity in students via her given theme "Ideas Are Our Greatest Weapons".

Her schoolmate and fellow semifinalist, Jeffrey Johan Adlan Disney,



spoke about how "ideas are doubleedged swords", as they could backfire and have unintended consequences.

"I have been working late into the night non-stop for the past week or so to prepare for this session," he said. "I was nervous and I'm still nervous! I'm going to be on tenterhooks for the next week until the finalists are announced."

The semi-finalists would be shortlisted for the finals based on their performance at the semi-finals, which assessed the substance of their speech, style and technique, general effectiveness and the ability to answer questions from a panel of judges.

Teresa Mah, Seonaidh Chai, Jagdish Bhain, Hamidah Ibrahim and chief judge Sheela Joseph from English Speaking Union (ESU) Malaysia made up the panel for this leg of the competition.

The finalists would be announced

next week and the national finals would be held on April 27 here.

The winner would represent the nation at the international competition in London next month.

## Rosmah did buy ring, says jeweller

PETALING JAYA: US-based fine jeweller Jacob & Co has issued a statement on a ring worth RM24.5mil that Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor denied purchasing.

In a 3.5 minute video posted by blogger Raja Petra Kamarudin on his Malaysia-Today.net site, Jacob & Co director Philip Nassimi said the 30.11-carat natural fancy blue grade cushion diamond ring valued at US\$8mil (RM24mil) was for viewing purposes by Maira Nazarbayev.

Nazarbayev is the mother of Daniyar Nazarbayev, who is the fiance of Rosmah's daughter Nooryana Najwa.

"The ring was not purchased by Madam Rosmah nor Maira Nazarbayev," he said in the video.

In showing a slew of documents, including the House Airway Bill and US Customs and Border Protection papers, Nassimi said the ring was shipped into Malaysia on April 15, 2011 and returned to the jeweller on May 13, 2011.

"It was shipped for exhibition and inspection purposes only, not for sale, to the attention of Maira Nazarbayev in care of Madam Rosmah Mansor," he said.

He said Rosmah's name was stated in the House Airway Bill because the rules stated that valuables have to be shipped in the care of a Malaysian and not a foreigner.
